PDX Citizen Noise Advisory Committee Meets May 11

The Portland International Airport Citizen Noise Advisory Committee will meet from 5:30-8 p.m. Thursday, May 11 in the St. Helens B conference room in the airport. The community is encouraged to attend, and public comments and questions are invited at 5:40 p.m. Questions and comments specifically about the six-month test of expanded Oregon Air National Guard continuous descent approach procedures at PDX are invited at 5:50 p.m. The full [agenda](#) is available at www.portofportland.com.

The committee is the Port of Portland's official forum for working with the community on issues related to aircraft noise. Committee representatives are from northwest Oregon and southwest Washington. Eleven members are appointed by various city and county jurisdictions, and four representatives are appointed by the Port in an effort to maintain geographic diversity on the committee. Technical assistance is provided by the Federal Aviation Administration and the Oregon Air National Guard.
