The advisory group to the Port of Portland Commission today announced the three recommended finalists for the position of executive director of the Port of Portland. Current Executive Director Bill Wyatt will retire from the Port on June 30, 2017.

Finalists:

- Stephanie Dawson, Chief Operation Officer, Port Authority of New York & New Jersey
- Curtis Robinhold, Deputy Executive Director, Port of Portland
