**CROSSWIND RUNWAY IN USE  
APRIL 6, 2018  
PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

Forecasts call for strong winds from the south this evening and throughout the weekend. Aircraft operating at Portland International Airport may be required to land or depart using the crosswind runway (Runway 21). This runway is oriented from south to north. Aircraft using the crosswind runway will be arriving over Vancouver communities north of PDX, and departing aircraft will fly over NE Portland neighborhoods, south of PDX.



Use of the crosswind runway will remain in effect until winds change back to the typical east/west direction.
