PORTLAND, ORE. (Aug. 29, 2014) – Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange Meets Sept. 3

Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange meets from 5:30-7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 3 at the City of Hillsboro Civic Center, 150 E. Main Street. The public is invited to attend and public comments are welcome.

The meeting will include an update on construction of the airport's parallel runway. In addition, the group will discuss information about the upcoming Oregon International Air Show and Runway Run events, and select a date for the next open house. Reports from the group's avgas-leaded fuel working group and noise working group will also be presented. A public comment period is at 7:15 p.m.

Hillsboro Airport Roundtable Exchange is a 22-member advisory group to the Port of Portland, formed to enhance and facilitate communication among people interested in Hillsboro Airport. Committee members represent the airport's diverse stakeholders such as nearby residents, neighboring businesses, airport tenants and users, and local jurisdictions.

Free parking is available, and the site is accessible by the TriMet MAX Blue Line at the Hatfield Government Center Station.
