NOTICE TO PORT OF PORTLAND TARIFF USERS

RE: REVISIONS TO PORT TARIFF NO. 8 – CHANGES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018

The electronic form of the Marine Tariff posted at https://portofportland.com/Marine/Tariff will govern in the event of any conflict with any paper form of the Marine Tariff or this notice.

The following changes will apply to the Port of Portland Marine Tariff:

- Tariff No. 8 has been renamed Tariff No. 9.
- Dockage increase approx 2.5%
- Fresh water consumption increase to \$6.10/CCF
- Added Sewer Service \$1,000 flat fee per call
- Increase CPI-U (2.3597%) of the following:
 - Billing/Rebilling Fee
 - Fendering System or Piling Repairs
 - o Rail Storage and/or Track Rental
 - o Equipment Rates
- Labor Rates increase for: Security Officers 1.39%, Electricians 6.12%, Other (inc. Plumbers)
 1.96%, Landscape Gardeners 1.54%
- Clarification of Section I, Item 3.B Liability for Environmental Damage and Costs
- Addition of "vessel" to Definition of "Facility User"
- Clarification of Part I, Section I, Item 10.B Environmental Laws
- Addition of Part I, Section I, Item 16.H Furnishing Services to and Reliance on Credit of Vessel
- Clarification of Part I, Section I, Item 17.B Other Coverage Requirements
- Clarification of Part I, Section I, Item 19 Indemnification; Reimbursement for Damage
- Change Part I, Section I, Item 22 to Limits of Liability, Waiver of Consequential Damages
- Clarification of Part I, Section I, Item 23 Governing Law and Venue

MISCELLANEOUS REVISIONS

Language in various provisions has been adjusted to clarify the meaning of the existing tariff obligations and to correct grammatical errors.
