 - Part of a City land use review?
 - Airside
 - Landside
 - Development or Alternation
- Mailed public notice
- Public meeting opportunity = PDX CAC
- Application for building permits

Existing Concourse A & Key Changes

- Concourse A constructed as a temporary facility by Horizon in 1988
- Built to serve smaller, regional markets
- Aircraft size and number of service frequencies have both increased
- Level of service has steadily decreased as a result



TCORE Major Project Scope & Phasing

Phase 1 - \$950M


- Western Expansion, including underground utilities
- New roof structure
- Concourse B Renovation, Concourse A Demolition, Remain Overnight Parking
- Terminal mezzanine relocations

Phase 2

- Terminal Core Renovation, including Ticket Lobby
- Baggage Claim Improvements



Concourse B Renovation Project Facts

- Includes demolition of Concourse A
- Renovation of existing Concourse B, including 18,000sf addition
- Reconfiguration of ground load operation with 6 aircraft parking positions and enhanced remain overnight parking
- Recommissioning of Gate B4
- Improved passenger concessions and amenities

 Requires temporary relocation of current Horizon operation to Concourse C



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

Concourse B Renovation Key Benefits

- Implementation of Airport Futures (Airport Master Plan)
- Provides long-term aircraft parking capacity for PDX
- Improves availability and configuration of remain overnight parking
- Vastly improves the PDX user experience
- Provides TriMet ability to double-track in the immediate vicinity and improve south-side bike and pedestrian access to PDX
