PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TEMPORARY RUNWAY CLOSURES (FEBRUARY 13-15, 2017)

Maintenance activities will require the temporary closure of the north parallel runway February 13-15, 2017, from 8 AM-4 PM each day.

During these closures, jet aircraft will use the south parallel runway, following noise abatement procedures that direct them over the Columbia River corridor, minimizing overflights of residential areas. In addition, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) air traffic controllers may need to route the small regional cargo feeder aircraft and commuter turboprop aircraft to the crosswind runway, which is oriented north/south. The Port continues to work with the FAA to minimize use of the crosswind runway whenever possible.
