FUTURE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS**

**January - March 2019**

**PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

DEICING VAULTS REHABILITATION \$750,000  
Rehabilitate several vaults of the PDX deicing system, including repair of concrete and some of the associated mechanical, electrical and controls equipment.

NW AIRFIELD WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PHASE 1A \$875,000  
Replace the domestic waterline servicing the Aircraft Rescue & Firefighting Facility (ARFF).

TERMINAL RESTROOM MODIFICATION \$2,900,000  
Upgrade finishes and layouts of selected public restrooms located throughout the PDX terminal.

TAXIWAY K REHABILITATION \$17,000,000  
Reconstruct pavement in asphalt and concrete. Other work elements include utility adjustments, electrical upgrades, storm drainage improvements, grading and pavement markings.

CONCOURSES C, D AND E PASSENGER BOARDING BRIDGES REPLACEMENT \$17,700,000  
Replace 16 Passenger Boarding Bridges along with electrical bus duct upgrades to support the new bridges, Preconditioned Air Units (PCAs) and Ground Power Units (GPUs).

**MARINE TERMINALS**

BERTH 601 FENDER, RUB RAIL AND DOLPHIN REHABILITATION \$800,000  
Install a new dolphin and replace rub rail at floating dock Berth 601.

TERMINALS 6 & 4 CCTV AND ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM UPGRADES \$1,250,000  
Replace and upgrade CCTV and Access Control Systems.

**April – June 2019**

**PORTLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

TERMINAL APRON RELAMP \$1,500,000  
Replace existing PDX Terminal apron wall and pole-mounted lights with LED lighting on Concourses A, B, C and D.

ENERGY EFFICIENCY UPGRADES \$2,500,000  
Upgrade lighting and lighting control systems, install high-speed rollup doors, perform retro-commissioning of HVAC system, and install electrical submeters on passenger boarding bridge equipment.

**MARINE TERMINALS**

T6 MAINTENANCE DREDGING 2019-2020 \$400,000  
Perform maintenance dredging at T6 (including transportation and placement of the dredged material), as well as potentially dredging at T4 or T5 in a subsequent year.

## July – September 2019

### **TROUTDALE AIRPORT**

#### TROUTDALE CONTROL TOWER AND BUILDING 1123 ROOFING

Replace Control Tower and Building 1123 roofing; upgrade fire alarm and electrical light fixtures.

### **MARINE TERMINALS**

#### MARINE ROOF REPAIR

Perform roof repairs for several buildings at Terminals 4 and 6.

\$160,000
